### Using Tell Me More at Home

Middle school students have the wonderful opportunity to participate in additional, independent language instruction through Tell Me More. Tell Me More is an adaptive, Internet-based language program that personalizes learning. The program provides students with exposure to a selected culture and language.

Students will have access to Tell Me More whenever they connect to the Internet. Headsets with microphones can be checked out from the school library. In order to have your child access the program independently, please use the following directions:

1. Log in to: <http://www.tellmoreeducation.com/>.
2. Enter student ID number for the user name.
3. Enter the student ID number for the password.
4. Click on *sign in*.
5. Begin learning language.
